The Society will not be accountable for any accident that may occur to any person attending the Show, whether as an Exhibitor, Visitor or otherwise.

Neither the Society nor any of its Officers or Servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever), to Exhibitors or their servants, or to any Exhibit or property brought into the Show Yard, or for anything else in connection with or arising out of, or attributable to the Society's Show.

All exhibitors are obliged tohave their animals insured for public liability. No Stallions allowed. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for anyconsequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him and for its description as given in the catalogue and shall indemnify the Society against all legal or otherproceedings in regard thereto.

The Society will endeavour to have the Catalogue as complete as possible and in accordance with the particulars given on the Entry Forms. It cannot, however, hold itself responsible for any additions, omissions, or mistakes which may occur for any reason, whatsoever, in the Catalogue. Exhibitors will be held responsible for the behaviour for their servants, and for the consequences of any misconduct of such servants.

DISCIPLINE

The Irish Shows Association expects and will insist upon appropriate behaviour from all Exhibitors and others participating in any of the activities at our Member Shows and will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour.

Inappropriate behaviour shall include but not be limited to the following:

- Profanity, coarse or yulgar language or gestures towards judges or Show officials.
- Harassment or bullying, including using words or actions that threaten, intimidate or undermine judges or other officials before, during or following Member Show activities
- Failure to follow rules and/or obey instructions.
- · Abusing any animal.

Disciplinary Procedures: Complaints of misconduct against an Exhibitor or other

participant at a Member Show shall be investigated and adjudicated upon by a subcommittee appointed by the Irish Shows Association. The said subcommittee shall consist of three members of the board of the Irish Shows Association and shall be known as the Disciplinary Committee. The Disciplinary Committee shall seek to ensure the existence of consistent, effective, fair and transparent complaint procedures and shall act in accordance with natural and constitutional justice.

Registration Number of Pedigree Cattle must be entered on the form.

Exhibitors are requested to have adequate Insurance cover their animals.

All exhibitors are obliged to have their animals insured for public liability.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS - CATTLE

Keepers wishing to show cattle in 2023 must obtain a Certificate of Compliance prior to the movement of the animal to the Show. This ensures that the animal (s) in question has the necessary TB, BR and BVD tests recorded on the Department's database and that the keeper presenting the animal is not restricted by the Department. Certificates of Compliance can be obtained online from the Animal identification and Movement (AIM) system through the www.agfood.ie facility or from the Cattle Movement Notification Agency. When applying for a Certificate of Compliance, keepers should not specify a destination herd.

On the day of the Show, the Certificate of Compliance should be presented to the Show Secretary along with the bovine passport for the animal.

The keeper and the Show Secretary will then sign the Movement Notification section of the Certificate which will then be sent to the local DVO for recording onto the AIM system.

Please note that only cattle for which a valid Certificate of Compliance is provided to the Show Secretary can be shown on the day of the Show.

Over next five years, the Minister has announced that €250,000 will be invested in the grassroots showing sector with the rolling out of a brand-new class aimed at showcasing the best of beef breeding heifers. The new class will be administered by the Irish Shows Association (ISA).

The "Breeder's Choice" class will be open to four and five star breeding heifers in two separate classes – traditional breeds and continental breeds. Pedigree as well as commercial heifers are eligible for the classes. Over the course if the summer, more than 60 shows will benefit from the new class.

The requirement for four and five star in-calf or maiden heifers aligns to the aims of the Beef Data and Genomics Programme (BDGP) and the incoming Suckler Carbon Efficiency Programme (SCBP) in the next CAP to increase the number of these heifers in the suckler herd. Four and five star animals in the suckler herd can bring greater milk as well as overall efficiency to beef animals.

Commenting on the major investment in the show sector, Minister McConalogue said: "The show network is the backbone of so many agri and rural communities. The show season is upon us and the excitement of getting an animal ready for your local show is hard bet. What is even more exciting is taking home a yellow, red or blue rosette. These are the marks of what makes a good animal a great animal."

"I'm delighted to work with the Irish Shows Association on this exciting, multi-year and long-term investment. This is a commitment from me and my Department to the Shows sector, to the quality of breeding cattle and to rural Ireland as a whole. I am looking forward to see the heifers and their owners in the new Breeder's Class at Shows across the country. It is also a commitment from the Government to continue to back rural Ireland in any way we can."

Jim Harrison, secretary of the Irish Shows Association welcomed the announcement by the Minister.
